Don't overwhelm them with being all over the place. Choose topics or pillars and stick with them. Frame your information by problem - solution - result.

Be findable. You are your brand. You're not running a secret business.

Tell people what the next steps are, *don't assume they know what to do next.*



Develop Systems In Your Business and Follow Them.

The system is the solution! Make sure that you are following up with people in a timely manner.

Track your conversations with them so that they understand that *you understand their needs*.
